General Officer Legal Orientation ATRRS 5F-F2. 1 Day.

Scope

The General Officer Legal Orientation course is an optional executive-level elective designed for newly promoted or reassigned Regular Army general officers, whose duties include GCMCA, GOSCA, authority to separate enlisted Soldiers IAW AR 635-200, Senior Responsible Officer, and carrying out similar authorities. This course informs and updates the target audience with the legal responsibilities and issues commonly faced by division, installation, and other Senior Commanders. It can be tailored to the specific needs of each attendee, with a range of optional military law topics to choose from.

The course is one-day long and takes place in-person at The Judge Advocate General's School-Army in Charlottesville, Virginia during designated available weeks.
